

By-Laws:

1. Secretary. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the constitution and By-Laws of the club and have the same with him/her at every meeting. He/she shall note all amendments, changes and additions on the constitution and shall permit it to be consulted by members upon request.

2. Membership. Full membership is open to licensed amateurs. Associate membership is open to those actively engaged in a class leading to an Amateur Radio license and all other interested persons. Full membership includes all club privileges as well as rights to hold a club office and to vote for club officers. Associate membership includes all club privileges except for the right to hold office and vote for club officers. Applications for membership shall be submitted at regular meetings.

3. Meetings. Regular meetings shall be held on Second Thursday of the month, 7:00 p.m. of each calendar month. Special meetings may be called by the President upon the written request of any five club members. Notices shall be sent to members concerning special meetings and the business to be transacted. Only such business as designated shall be transacted. Such notices shall be sent so that they arrive not less than 24 hours before the meeting.

4. Dues. A regular Yearly assessment of \$ \$10.00 per member is hereby assessed in accordance with the provisions of Article V of the constitution for the purpose of providing funds for expenses. First time Applications for membership into the Montcalm Area Amateur Radio Club after October 1 shall be given three (3) months free membership upon receipt of the \$10.00 dollar fee for dues.

5. Interference committee. This committee shall consist of five members (appointed by the club President). The committee shall direct investigation, invite proper inquires, establish technical facts and testimony and report its results to the club.

6. ARES/RACES Committee. This committee shall consist of Emergency Coordinators and Assistant Emergency Coordinators. The committee shall give a full report at each meeting with facts and information relating to ARES/RACES to keep us all up to date.

7. Public Relations Committee. This committee shall consist of at least two (2) members to promote Amateur Radio. This committee shall be appointed by the President.
